Subject: "Ease of doing Business" viz a viz affiliation of Private Educational institutions with TKBOSE.

Reference: Decisions taken in the meeting held on 06-01 2023 in the office chamber of the Principal Secretary School Education Department/Chairman IKBOSE.

In pursuance to the decisions taken in the above-referred meeting regarding the Extension of Affiliation / Upgradation/ New affiliation to the private Educational institutions, it is hereby notified for information of all the concerned that;

- 1. For Extension of Affiliation / Upgradation/ New affiliation all mandatory Safety Certificates must be in force at the time of submitting the online application.
- a) For Extension of affiliation: In case any safety certificate expires during the time period between applying online and the affiliation committee meeting. The head of the institute shall produce an under-process certificate/ receipt of having applied for renewal of the certificate to the concerned department. Extension to such institution/s shall be granted if otherwise found eligible, subject to the condition that the institution shall produce the required safety certificates within a period of 03 months from the date of Extension is granted.
- b) For Upgradation & New affiliation Institutions: All the mandatory safety certificates have to be valid at the time of granting affiliation.
- 2. The condition of NOC from the pollution department has been waived of. Instead of uploading NOC from Pollution Department, the institutions shall upload an affidavit to the effect "that there is no noise-causing unit/ industry in the vicinity of the school and if at any instant it is found that the school has concealed any information in this regard, the JKBOSE shall be at liberty to cancel the affiliation of the school.

Also during the inspection of the institution, the joint inspection team shall ascertain that the institution is not situated near any industry.

3. Instead of uploading a Chemical, Safety Certificate issued by the Concerned SDMs on the affiliation portal, the institutions shall henceforth upload an affidavit sworn in before a first-class Magistrate, that the head of the management committee/ Principal of the concerned institution shall be responsible and accountable for the possession and safekeeping of the chemicals and the acids in the school premises.

The schools shall, however, comply with the conditions as laid down in the Circular No Edu/Legal/K/Misc/SC/129/2013 dated 11-10-2013 issued by the School Education Department Civil Secretariat.

This notification is issued with the approval of the authority and shall supersede all notifications regarding the subject matter issued by JKBOSE, earlier.
